Alison's new play *All At Sea*, a co-production between Live Theatre and Stephen Joseph Theatre, opens at the end of September. Directed by Maria Crocker (*Hadestown*), the play is a comedy drama inspired by the notorious 'canoe conman' true story.

Alison's short film *Doppelgänger* is currently available to watch on BBC iPlayer.

Earlier this year Alison's play *The Soaking of Vera Shrimp* was produced by Patch of Blue at the Adelaide Fringe Festival, where it won the Overall Critics Choice Award.

Alison's play *Birdie* is a previous Finalist for The Women's Prize for Playwriting. The judging panel's commentary included "an outstanding, highly accomplished play which evinces your terrific skill and power as a theatre writer".

Alison has playtexts published by Nick Hern Books, Concord Theatricals, and Methuen Drama. Her play for young people *Tuesday* is a set play on WJEC's GCSE drama specification.
